Instructions

1. Gather assorted natural elements, and any other desired items along with the suggested materials.
2. Brainstorm some designs.
3. Find a large work area that can be undisturbed for a few days.
4. Glue your bottles together and fill in crevasses and desired decorative areas with aluminum foil.
5. Cover your structure with polymer clay and sculpt to your heart's desire.
6. Bake according to your packaging instructions.
7. Paint. I don't recommend oil paints due to the slow drying time, but any others including pigmented inks and food coloring could work.
8. Build your roof. Handy to have a foil base to glue things to.
9. Add details and accessories
10. Place in your garden and admire your creation.

Tools Suggested Materials

Hot Glue Gun & Lots of glue sticks

Oven & Cookie sheet

Scissors & Skewer/sculpting stick

Aluminum Foil

Glass Jars

Polymer Clay

Moss

Nature objects: bark, rocks, sticks, etc...

Suggested Materials

- 1-2lb. Of Polymer Clay
- Hot Glue Sticks & Gun
- Dried/Pres. Moss
- Glass Jars
- Kabob Skewer
- Aluminum Foil
- Scissors

- Round Glass/Rolling Pin
- Paint *anything but oil
- Natural Objects:
 - Rocks
 - Bark
 - Twigs
 - Pinecones
 - Acorns, etc.

PARTY PLANNING CHECKLIST

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ONE MONTH BEFORE

Determine the main W's. **Who** will be attending, **What** will be needed, **When** and **Where** will the party take place, and **Why** you're celebrating.

- Set the date, time and place as well as a guest count & RSVP date.
- Decide on a theme, and how you will make the party special.
- Determine your budget and estimate the costs of each party item to make sure it's feasible. (food, entertainment, decorations, etc...)

3 WEEKS BEFORE

- Mail or E-mail invitations to your guest list.
- Source and order party favors, decorations, and flowers.
- Rent/buy extra chairs, tables, place settings, serving pieces, and linens (if needed) from your local rental company. *Churches will often lend tables and chairs to members for little to no cost.
- Reserve your tent, and portable bathrooms if needed.
- Reserve your caterer and DJ/Band if using one.

2 WEEKS BEFORE

- Create place cards. *Don't fill them out at this time.
- Plan menu and create shopping list if not using a caterer.
- Draft a timeline for preparing each dish if doing it yourself.
- Prepare any items that can be frozen.
